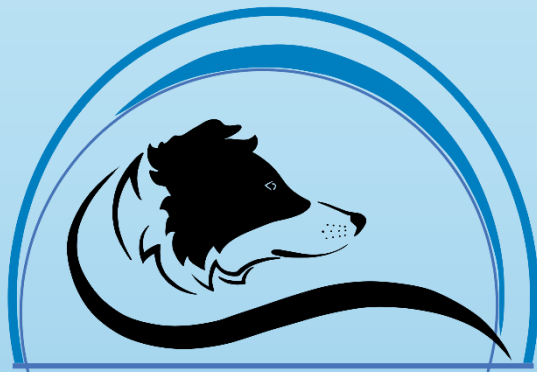

Introducing the CHC Championship Stream

Celebrate your team's growth, confidence, and skill with our brand-new extended title pathway

Once you've earned your Class Title in any level, you can continue running in that same level to collect Excellence Titles and work toward a Championship Title

It's a flexible, confidence-building pathway designed for teams who want more time developing distance skills, enjoy the challenge of refining their work, or simply love competing in their favourite level

CHC Championship Stream – Official Rules

1. Eligibility

A team becomes eligible for the Championship Stream only **after earning the CHC Class Title** for that level (e.g., NHDC – *Novice Hooper Dog of Canada*)

No scores earned prior to achieving the Class Title may be counted toward Championship Stream requirements

2. Earning Excellence Titles

After earning the Class Title, a team may continue competing in the same level to earn **Excellence Titles**

Excellence Titles are earned by accumulating qualifying scores (“Q’s”) within that titled level

3. Earning the Championship Title

A team must earn **three Excellence Titles** in the same level to achieve that level’s **Championship Title**

NHEC (Novice Hoopers Excellence)

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NPEC (Novice Parkour Excellence)

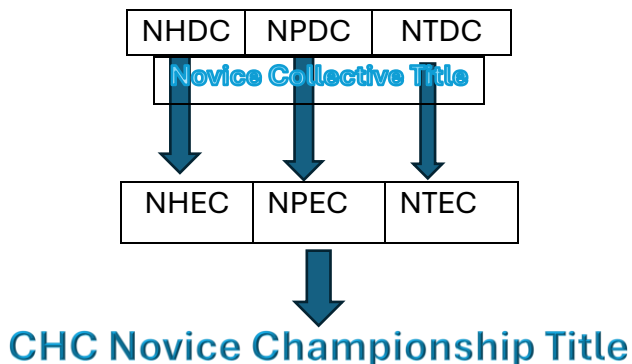
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NTEC (Novice Tungo Excellence)



CHC Novice Championship Title

Excellence Titles may only be earned within the level in which the team already holds the Class Title



4. Qualifying Scores (Q's)

Each Excellence Title requires **10 Q's**

Accumulate **30 points = 1 Q**

Only runs earning **10 points or more** will count towards earning a Q

5-point runs **do not count** towards Q accumulation

5. Dual-Level Participation

Once a team has earned their **Class Title** in a level, they may:

- **Enter the next level** to begin earning points toward the next Class Title, **and**
- **Remain in the titled level** to earn points toward the Championship Stream Titles
- Teams may progress to higher levels at any time or return to a previous titled level to continue working toward Championship Titles

Reminder: teams must have earned a Class Title to be eligible to enter the next class level

6. Optional Participation

The Championship Stream is **entirely optional**

Teams may choose to pursue Championship Titles, move on to higher levels, or return to previous levels at their discretion.

7. Purpose of Championship Stream

The Championship Stream is designed for all teams, especially those who:

- Prefer to continue developing distance skills before advancing
- Benefit from additional confidence-building opportunities
- Enjoy refining foundational Hoopers skills within a familiar level

Because Hoopers emphasizes distance work, the Championship Stream provides a structured way to continue building those skills

8. Effective Date

Effective immediately, all eligible post-Class Title runs earning 10 points or more, including previously earned runs, will count toward Championship Stream Qs

Only runs earned after the team has achieved the Class Title may be applied toward Championship Stream Titles

Runs earned before the Class Title are not eligible

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CHC - AHEC CHC Advanced Hooper Excellence AHDC + 10 Q's 30 points = 1 Q	CHC - APEC CHC Advanced Parkour Excellence APDC + 10 Q's 30 points = 1 Q	CHC - ATEC CHC Advanced Tungo Excellence ATDC + 10 Q's 30 points = 1 Q
